

## Call for Papers

### JEQ Special Section: Microbial Fate and Transport in the Subsurface

Interested individuals are invited to contribute a paper to a special section of the *Journal of Environmental Quality*, which will focus on "Microbial Transport and Fate in the Subsurface."

Thomas Harter of the University of California Davis and Jack Schijven of the University of Utrecht will serve as guest editors for this special issue.

Papers on this topic that include original research, reviews and analyses, modeling, monitoring, and risk assessment are welcome. All submissions will undergo a rigorous peer-review process.

Modeling papers should include measured data for validation and/or a sensitivity analysis. Monitoring studies will only be considered if they test a hypothesis that will advance our knowledge and understanding of environmental concepts.

The first seven pages of printed papers are free, and a \$200 fee (\$100 for members of one of our societies) will be assessed for each additional printed page. Authors may make their article open-access for a fee of \$800.
